### Player Selection Weekend

The 2005 Shrine Bowl coaches gathered at the Holiday Inn in Rock Hill, SC on Saturday and Sunday October 15-16 and selected their players for the 69th Annual Shrine Bowl Game. Game rosters are listed in this edition.

When the Shrine Bowl coaches met they narrowed down these nominations to 44 per team with no more than two players from any one school. "This is a formative task", said Ron Long regarding the process. In addition to the information provided by the high school coaches the Shrine Bowl coaches will also review the statistics from the various combines that were conducted in the spring.

The players roster were announced to the press and media by a WEBCAST on Thursday, October 20. Each player was notified by his high school coach after the coach was notified by a Shriner representing

Ron Long, Shrine Bowl Athletic Director, sent letters to 547 head football coaches in North and South Carolina asking for their nominations for players for the Shrine Bowl teams. Each school could nominate four players, two lineman and 2 backs. If a coach wanted to nominate a specialty player; i.e. punter or kicker, then he could do so as a substitute for one of his four total nominations. Over 300 nominations were received by the Shrine Bowl office.

## BOARD APPROVES SHRINE BOWL BASKETBALL CONCEPT

A motion was made, seconded and approved at the August Board of Governors meeting in New Bern, NC to lay initial groundwork to conduct a High School All-Star Basketball game by the Shrine Bowl of the Carolinas. A committee will be formed to lay out the groundwork and tournament rules. The concept includes a multi-state all star format with the first game in the Raleigh area.

## CASH PRIZE FOR SHRINE UNITS AT PARADE
